Important Dates

Fall Pretesting Window: 8/15 – 9/30

Post-testing: 10/10 – 6/2

Winter Pretesting Window: 1/2 – 1/27

Field-testing 10/10 – 4/21

No specific testing window for Teacher Effectiveness this year, districts should schedule Post-testing in combination with pretesting to meet their OTES reporting deadlines.



Field Testing

This year the Transportation Career Field is in field testing.

- Field tests include more items, plan for additional time to complete testing
- Field tests have **no Pretests**. If you use WebXam Pretests for OTES, please make other arrangements for evaluating Student Gain



Pretesting Credits

- Credits remain \$2 per test delivered and can be paid for with a Purchase Order or by Credit Card.
- Credits can be added to your administrative account for later assignment to teachers.
- Credits added to your administrative account cannot be used until they are assigned to teacher.



New Test Activation process

- Students no longer use passwords that do not change to take tests. Instead access codes are assigned for each testing session.

Why?

- This enhances the security of the WebXam platform
- Secures student accounts for additional uses, such as CTAG Data-Sharing Assent review and viewing reports



About Access Codes

- Access codes can be downloaded at the end of the Test Activation process or via the Activation Report
- New options for downloading are available
- Access codes are NOT case-sensitive
- Access codes will work from 1 hour before the testing window to one hour after the testing window closes
- If a student is taking multiple tests the same day, all tests will use the same access code.



- The CTAG Assent Report was added as a preview during the last school year
- The report allow teachers and administrators to see whether students assented to data-sharing with Higher Education for college credit
- For tests taken in the current school year, a window can be opened for the student to update their assents

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






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
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Total # unique Transportation SMEs = 72

■ Post-Secondary ■ Secondary ■ Industry





Detecting test security breaches

Virtual Item Writing

- Has many pros, but has a higher risk of “item theft”
- Using data analysis techniques to detect item theft

Test Security Analyses

- Track every item that an individual SME sees during workshops
- Using built-in features of the WebXam system to check for possible preknowledge for students of workshop participants



Designing the Blueprint

- ◎ Blueprint tells us how many items to write to each outcome included in course outline
- ◎ Based on importance, amount of content (competencies) and how easily can write questions
- ◎ Importance and easiness based on ratings
- ◎ Should receive a survey this year if teaching Business, Finance, and Marketing survey
- ◎ Fill it out– this helps us figure out which content standards are most important!

Why You Should Take This Survey

- ⦿ We know there are outcomes that aren't super vital to the course
- ⦿ If an outcome is rated as very unimportant, we won't write questions to it
- ⦿ Strand ratings can de-emphasize Strand 1
- ⦿ Method is used for certification and certificate organizations
- ⦿ This is the easiest way to impact content without writing questions
- ⦿ The more participants we have, the more precise the blueprint is
- ⦿ We also monitor comment data for feedback before each workshop



Example Ratings Question

Below are the outcomes included in the career field Transportation Systems. To help plan how many items to write for each outcome for the course **Aviation Powerplant Systems and Components**, we need a little more information. First, we need an idea of how **important** each outcome is to the course as a whole, rated on a scale of 1 (Not at all Important) to 5 (Extremely Important). In addition, we need to know how **difficult** it is to write multiple choice items to each outcome, on a scale of 1 (Very Difficult) to 5 (Very Easy).

Please note that these are outcomes for the entire career field, as the outcomes included in each course have not been finalized by ODE. The final course outlines will only include a subset of these outcomes.
